On April 11, 2014, the JUDICIAL BOARD officially received a Petition for Consideration (No. 14-1) from Petitioner Ian Cocroft against the USA Election Board et al.

The JUDICIAL BOARD has GRANTED the Petition for Consideration (No. 14-1) on the matter of *Ian Cocroft v. USA Elections Board et al.*, and will be formally considering the case.

The issue(s) to be considered will be the following:

- 1. Is the time set aside for "hours of the voting" set by the 2014 Spring General Election Calendar presented by the Election Board in violation of Election Code Section V.A.3?
- What is the definition of "three (3) full days?"
 Election Code Section V.A.3 specifies: The Spring General Election shall be at least three (3) full days in duration.

A PRELIMINARY HEARING date has been set for Wednesday, April 23, 2014 from 5:00-7:00 pm, which will be held in CLOSED SESSION.
