MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESS

RE: Press Release: *The Daily Bruin v. U.S.A. Election Board et al.*

On May 6, 2014, the JUDICIAL BOARD officially received a Petition for Consideration (No. 14-4) from PETITIONER The Daily Bruin against the USA Election Board et al., the RESPONDENT.

The JUDICIAL BOARD has GRANTED the Petition for Consideration (No. 14-4) on the matter of *The Daily Bruin v. U.S.A. Election Board et al.*, and will be formally considering the case.

The issue(s) to be considered will be the following:

1. Does the Election Code grant the Election Board the authority over non-paid media appearances of USAC election candidates, or over non-paid media coverage with regards to USAC election candidates?
2. Is the Election Board's threat of sanctions on USAC presidential candidates for appearing in the Daily Bruin segment, Long Story Short, within the jurisdiction of the Election Board?

A PRELIMINARY HEARING date has been set for **Monday, May 12, 2014 from 2:00-3:00 pm**, which will be held in CLOSED SESSION.
