RE: Information: *Brandon J. Broukhim v. USAC Election Board*

Information:

On April 8, 2019, the JUDICIAL BOARD officially accepted PETITIONER Brandon J. Broukhim's Petition for Consideration (No. 19-1) against the USAC Election Board, the RESPONDENT.

The JUDICIAL BOARD will be acting in its capacity as the board of appeals for the USAC Election Board. See USAC Constitution Article VI.B.3 and USAC Election Code 11.4.

The JUDICIAL BOARD has GRANTED the Petition for Consideration (No. 19-1) on the matter of *Brandon J. Broukhim v. USAC Election Board* and will be formally considering the case.

The issue(s) to be considered will be the following:

1. Did the Election Board violate USA Constitution Article 3.B.1?
2. Did the Election Board violate USAC Election Code Article 1.2?
3. Did the Election Board violate USAC Election Code Article 2.1.2?
4. Did the Election Board violate USAC Election Code Article 2.4.1.o.i?
5. Did the Election Board violate USAC Election Code Article 2.6.1.a,d,g,h,j?
6. Did the Election Board violate USAC Election Code Article 2.8.1.a?

The Judicial Board orders that the Election Board may not upload the final candidate names to the UCLA portal until the Judicial Board has released a decision in (No. 19-1) All other election activities may carry on as normal.

Judicial Board procedures have been ACCELERATED.
